

Bernat Solo SWEATER TO KNIT

SIZES

Bust measurement

Extra-Small	28-30	ins	[71-76	cm]
Small	32-34	"	[81.5-86.5	"]

Finished bust

MATERIALS: Bernat Solo (80 g/2.8 oz)

Sizes	XS	S	M	L	XL	2XL	
	7	7	7	8	8	9	balls

Sizes 6 mm (U.S. 10) and 6.5 mm (U.S. 10½) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 2 st holders.

GAUGE: 12 sts x 17 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

BACK

With **larger needles, cast on 49 (**55-61-67-73-79**) sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Rep last 2 rows (K1. P1) ribbing twice more (6 rows of ribbing in all), inc 1 st at center of last row. 50 (**56-62-68-74-80**) sts.

Cont in stocking st until work from beg measures 13½ ins [34 cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes: Cast off 4 (**4-5-6-7-8**) sts beg next 2 rows. 42 (**48-52-56-60-64**) sts.**

Cont even until armhole measures 8½ (**9-9-9½-10-10**) ins [21.5 (**23-23-24.5-25.5-25.5**) cm], ending with a purl row.

Next row: Cast off 10 (**13-15-16-18-19**) sts. K22 (**22-22-24-24-26**) (including st on needle after cast off). Slip these 22 (**22-22-24-24-26**) sts onto a st holder. Cast off rem 10 (**13-15-16-18-19**) sts.

FRONT: Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Cont even until armhole measures 6 (**6½-6½-7-7-7**) ins [15 (**16.5-16.5-18-18-18**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape neck: Next row: K15 (**18-20-21-23-24**) (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a st holder.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows, then every following alt row 3 times. 10 (**13-15-16-18-19**) sts. Cont even until armhole measures same length as Back, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

With RS of work facing, leave center 12 (**12-12-14-14-16**) sts on a st holder. Join yarn to rem 15 (**18-20-21-23-24**) sts and knit to end of row.

Next row: Purl.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows, then every following alt row 3 times. 10 (**13-15-16-18-19**) sts. Cont even until armhole measures same length as Back, ending with WS facing for next row. Cast off.

SLEEVES

With **smaller** needles, cast on 29 (**29-29-31-31-31**) sts. Work 6 rows in (K1. P1) ribbing as given for Back.

Change to **larger** needles and inc 1 st each end of needle on 3rd and every following 6th row to 47 (**49-49-53-55-55**) sts.

Cont even until Sleeve from beg measures 18 (**18½-18½-18½-18½-19**) ins [45.5 (**47-47-47-47-48**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row. Place a marker at each end of last row.

Work 4 (**4-6-8-8-10**) rows even.

Shape Top: Cast off 5 (**5-5-6-6-6**) sts beg next 6 rows. Cast off rem 17 (**19-19-17-19-19**) sts.

FINISHING

Neckband: Sew right shoulder seam. With RS of work facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 9 (**9-9-9-12-12**) sts down left front neck edge. K12 (**12-12-14-14-16**) from Front st holder. Pick up and knit 9 (**9-9-9-12-12**) sts up right front neck edge. K22 (**22-22-24-24-26**) from Back st holder, dec 1 st at center. 51 (**51-51-55-61-65**) sts.

Beg on a 2nd row, work 5 rows in ribbing, as given for Back. Cast off in ribbing. Sew left shoulder and neckband seam.

Sew in sleeves placing rows above markers along cast off sts at armholes of front and back to form square armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.
