

# 3. Eight Shades Ripple



## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 47<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> x 61 ins [120.5 x 155 cm].

## GAUGE

12 dc and 8 rows = 4 ins [10 cm].

Bernat® Super Value (197 g/7 oz; 389 m/426 yds)

## INSTRUCTIONS

With A, ch 272 loosely. (Note-mark every 50th ch with a safety pin to make counting easier).

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook.

\*Miss next 2 ch. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch – V-st made. Ch 1. Miss next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Ch 1. Miss next 2 ch. V-st in next ch. Miss next 2 ch. [(1 dc. Ch 1) 3 times. 1 dc] all in next ch. Miss next 2 ch. V-st in next ch. Ch 1. Miss next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Ch 1. Miss next 2 ch. V-st in next ch. Miss next 2 ch.\*\* *Yoh and draw up a loop in next ch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook. Miss next 2 ch. Yoh and draw up a loop in next ch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook – counts as cluster.* Rep from \* to last 25 ch.

Rep from \* to \*\* once. (*Yoh and draw up a loop in next ch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook*) twice. *Yoh and draw through all loops on hook – dc2tog made.* Join B. Turn.

**2nd row:** With B, ch 3. 1 dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st. Miss next dc of same V-st. \*V-st in next dc. Ch 1. 1 dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st. Ch 1. V-st in next ch-1 sp. [(1 dc. Ch 1) 3 times. 1 dc] all in next ch-1 sp. V-st in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 1 dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st. Ch 1. Miss next dc of same V-st. V st in next dc.\*\**Yoh and draw up a loop in next ch-1 sp. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook. Miss next cluster. Yoh and draw up a loop in next ch-1 sp. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook – cluster made.* Miss next dc of last V-st.

*...and now*



Rep from \* across, ending at \*\*. Dc2tog over next ch-1 sp and top of turning ch.

Join C. Turn.

Last row forms pat.

Cont in pat working stripes as follows:  
1 row each C, D, E, F, G, H, A, and B.

These 8 rows form Stripe Pat.

Cont in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx 60 ins [152.5 cm], ending with A row of Stripe Pat. **Do not** fasten off. Work left edging as follows:

**Left Edging: 1st row:** (RS). With A, work sc evenly down side edge of Blanket to foundation ch. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc across. Fasten off.



**Right Edging:** With RS facing, join A with sl st in bottom corner of foundation ch.

**1st row:** Ch 1. Work sc evenly up side edge of Blanket to top corner. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

**Fringe:** Cut 12 inch [30.5 cm] lengths of D and F. Taking 3 strands tog for each fringe, alt D and F for fringe across bottom and top edges of Afghan, working fringe in each ch-2 sp across foundation row or each ch-1 sp across top edge. Trim fringe evenly.
